



### Impact of Pupil Premium Funding 2017-18

A sum of £64,975 was allocated to Wellfield Middle School in 2017-18. The table below shows where the funding was allocated, the associated costs and the impact on these students. The school uses funding to improve outcomes for disadvantaged students through a combination of quality teaching for all and focused spending according to areas of greatest need linked to wellbeing, attainment and progress.

Part funded salary of Literacy Lead.	£3,500	Focused drive to improve literacy standards with focus on Pupil Premium students.
School to school improvement through the implementation of the LEARNS project (teaching and learning).	£3,000	Increased level of active learning and excellence for all students.
Part funding salary of extra Year 6 teacher.	£21,000	Allowed for smaller classes in Year 6 for English and Maths, with targeted support for Pupil Premium students.

Improved pastoral, safeguarding and SEN monitoring through CPOMS information management package.	£966	Better knowledge of barriers to learning and strategies to overcome them for individuals.
Subsidised enrichment visits.	£3,100	Improved engagement in the curriculum and cultural capital.
Hegarty Maths Package.	£1,200	Homework support provided through app on iPads.
Staffing for attendance strategy work.	£2,500	Improved relationships between home and school. Increased attendance.
